




Front seat, removing and installing

CAUTION!

Before working on the electrical system, disconnect battery Ground (GND) strap.


Notes:

- Depending on variations in vehicle equipment, slight deviations from the removing and installing procedure must be considered.
- Before disconnecting the battery, obtain radio anti-theft code.
- After disconnecting the battery make sure that the vehicle equipment (radio, clock and power window regulators) are checked according to repair manual and/or operating instructions.



Removing

- Slide seat forward.
- Unclip cap -1- from tunnel side of cover slip -3-, unscrew screw -2-, unclip cover strip from seat rail (arrow -A-) and remove (arrow -B-).
- Unclip cap -4- from rocker panel side cover strip -6-, unscrew screw -5-, unclip cover strip from seat rail (arrow -C-) and remove (arrow -D-).
- Slide seat backward.
- Unscrew bolts -7- (23 Nm).
- Slide seat to the back out of guide rails.



Note:

Before disconnecting ignition and Ground wires, technician must discharge from himself any electrostatic charge (to do this briefly touch striker for door or body).

- Disconnect connector for side airbag -1- from coupling station -2-.
- Disconnect connector for seat heater -3-, if available, from coupling station.
- Insert connector -4- (airbag adapter VAS 5094) in connector housing -5-.



Installing


- Install in reverse order of removal.

Note:

If warning light (K75) for airbag signals a malfunction after assembly, erase DTC memory with Scan Tool VAG 1551 and check again.

Front backrest, removing and installing

Assembly overview - front seat

- 1 Seat trim, right
- 2 Belt lock
- 3 Seat
- 4 Backrest
- 5 Trim collar
- 6 Adjusting knob (lumbar support)
- 7 Seat trim, left
- 8 Adjustment knob (backrest)
- 9 Adjustment lever (Seat height)
- 10 Expanding pins
- 11 Screw for left trim




Removing


- Remove seat \Rightarrow page 72-3.

Assembly overview \Rightarrow page 72-6.

- Remove belt lock -1-.









- Remove adjustment knob 8 -.
- Press four expanding pins 10 of adjustment lever 9 inward and remove adjustment lever.
- Remove trim 1 -.
- Remove screw 11 -.
- Remove trim 7 -.





Disconnect connector -1- for backrest heater.



- Remove screws -1- on both sides of the seat and remove backrest.


Installing

- Install in reverse order of removal.

Note:

Screws -1- must be secured with locking fluid D 000 600 A2 (Tightening torque 20 Nm).





Lumbar support, removing and installing


Note:

Lumbar support permits backrest adjustment at lumbar area.


Removing

- Remove seat ⇒ page 72-3.
- Remove backrest ⇒ page 72-6.
- Separate beading strip -1- of cover -2- with screwdriver (arrows).







- Loosen rear cover -1- from front cover -2-.




- Disconnect connector -1- for backrest heater.




- Remove tension wire -1- from seat frame -2-.



Cut through three upholstery clips-1-.




- Pry off adjustment knob -1- and trim collar -2-.



- Slide up cover -1- and remove screws -2- for lumbar support adjustment -3-.





- Unclip lumbar support -1- (arrows) and remove backrest frame.

Installing


- Install in reverse order of removal.



8-way seat trim, removing

- Remove seat \Rightarrow page 72-3.
- Remove belt lock \Rightarrow page 72-7.
- Unclip cap -1- and remove bolt -2-.
- Unclip right seat trim -3-.
- Remove screws -4- and -5-.
- Disconnect connector -6-.
- Unclip left seat trim -7-.






8-way seat control module, removing

Note:

Control module is located under the driver seat.

- Remove seat \Rightarrow page 72-3.
- Disconnect connector -6-.
- Remove screws -1- and -2-.
- Remove control module -3-.






8-way seat operating unit, removing

- Remove seat ⇒ page 72-3.
- Remove 8-way seat trim ⇒ page 72-16.
- Remove two screws (arrows) on the inner side of the left seat trim and remove operating unit.






8-way seat seat length adjuster, removing

- Remove seat \Rightarrow page 72-3.
- Separate connector -1- with a screwdriver in direction of arrow.
- Remove eight screws -2- (four on each side).
- Remove seat length adjuster -3- in direction of arrow.






8-way seat front drive for seat height adjustment, removing

- Remove seat ⇒ page 72-3.
- Separate connector -1- with a screwdriver in direction of arrow.
- Remove three bolts -3-.
- Remove front drive -2-.






8-way seat rear drive for seat height adjustment, removing

- Adjust seat to top most position.
- Remove seat \Rightarrow page 72-3.
- Remove trim ⇒ page 72-16.
- Separate connector -1- with a screwdriver in direction of arrow.
- Remove three bolts -3-.
- Remove rear drive -2-.






8-way seat drive for backrest adjustment, removing

- Remove seat ⇒ page 72-3.
- Remove trim ⇒ page 72-16.
- Loosen cover in lower area of backrest and roll up ⇒ page 74-4.
- Separate connector -1- with a screwdriver in direction of arrow.





- Pry off locking washer -2- from shaft -3- with a screwdriver.
- Drive out shaft -3- with hammer and mandrel approx. 15 cm in the backrest frame.
- Unscrew nut -4-.
- Remove drive -5-.
